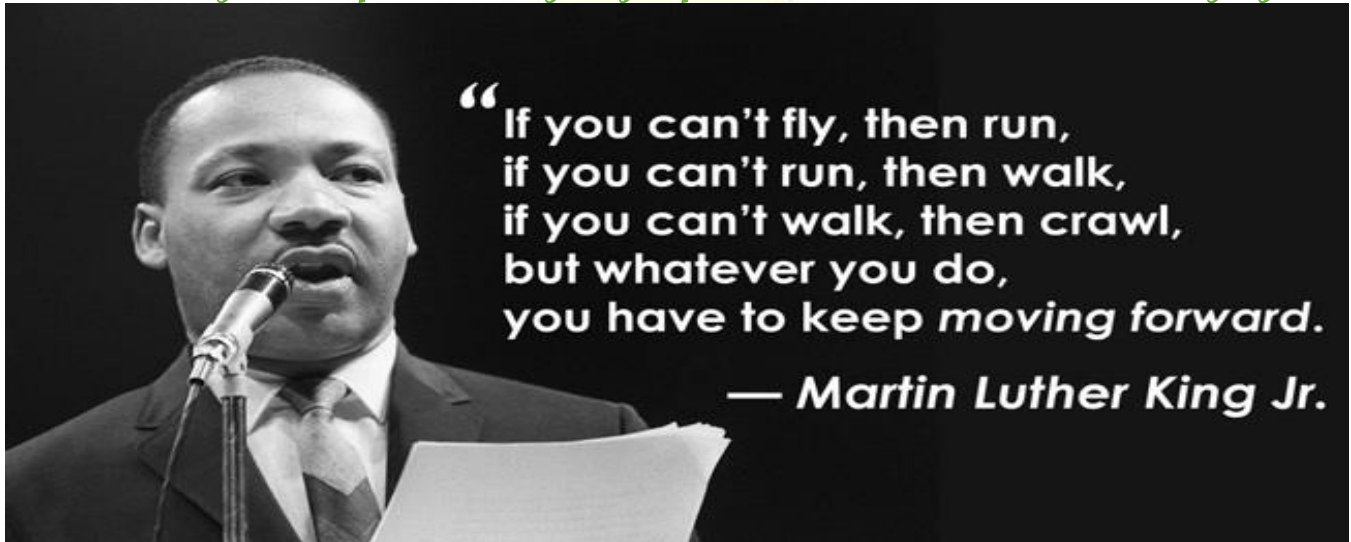

WEEKLY SCRIPTURE: JOSHUA 2:1-14 (NLT)

Help From An Unlikely Source (Part 2 in the Joshua Series)

¹ Then Joshua secretly sent out two spies from the Israelite camp at Acacia Grove. He instructed them, "Scout out the land on the other side of the Jordan River, especially around Jericho." So the two men set out and came to the house of a prostitute named Rahab and stayed there that night. ² But someone told the king of Jericho, "Some Israelites have come here tonight to spy out the land." ³ So the king of Jericho sent orders to Rahab: "Bring out the men who have come into your house, for they have come here to spy out the whole land." ⁴ Rahab had hidden the two men, but she replied, "Yes, the men were here earlier, but I didn't know where they were from." ⁵ They left the town at dusk, as the gates were about to close. I don't know where they went. If you hurry, you can probably catch up with them." ⁶ (Actually, she had taken them up to the roof and hidden them beneath bundles of flax she had laid out.) ⁷ So the king's men went looking for the spies along the road leading to the shallow crossings of the Jordan River. And as soon as the king's men had left, the gate of Jericho was shut. ⁸ Before the spies went to sleep that night, Rahab went up on the roof to talk with them. ⁹ "I know the LORD has given you this land," she told them. "We are all afraid of you. Everyone in the land is living in terror." ¹⁰ For we have heard how the LORD made a dry path for you through the Red Sea when you left Egypt. And we know what you did to Sihon and Og, the two Amorite kings east of the Jordan River, whose people you completely destroyed. ¹¹ No wonder our hearts have melted in fear! No one has the courage to fight after hearing such things. For the LORD your God is the supreme God of the heavens above and the earth below. ¹² "Now swear to me by the LORD that you will be kind to me and my family since I have helped you. Give me some guarantee that ¹³ when Jericho is conquered, you will let me live, along with my father and mother, my brothers and sisters, and all their families." ¹⁴ "We offer our own lives as a guarantee for your safety," the men agreed. "If you don't betray us, we will keep our promise and be kind to you when the LORD gives us the land."

Room in the INN offers a unique way for people of faith to become directly involved with individuals who are homeless. The ministry partners with Urban Ministers to provide shelter and food for the homeless during the winter months. This season, CNJ is hosting 11 men from January 14th and thereafter the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month through March.

Cleanup Bucket Contents (*must be in these exact amounts*)

- 5 scouring pads
- 7 sponges, assorted sizes
- 1 scrub brush
- 5 dust masks
- 50 clothespins
- Clothesline (two 50 ft. OR one 100 ft.)
- 1 box dry laundry detergent, 50-78 oz.
- 1 pair work gloves
- 2 pair latex gloves (like Playtex)
- 1 liquid concentrated household cleaner (like Lysol), 12 oz.*
- 1 bottle liquid disinfectant dish soap (like Dawn), 25 oz.*
- 1 pkg. cleaning towels (18 reusable, like Easy Wipes)
- 24-count roll heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon)
- 1 bottle insect repellent (drops OR lotion, NOT aerosol), 6-14 oz.*
